DECISION

DECISION

This third annual report on licensing electric suppliers is submitted to the General Assembly pursuant to Section 16-245y(d) of the General Statutes of Connecticut. Under this section, the Department of Public Utility Control (Department) is charged with reporting:

1. The number of applicants for licensure during the proceeding 12 months;
2. The number of applicants licensed by the Department; and
3. The average period of time taken to process a license application.

During the period December 1, 1999 (the date of the second annual report) through December 13, 2000, the Department received 13 applications, ten for electric supplier licenses and three for aggregator licenses. Two of the applicants for an electric supplier license withdrew their applications.

Between December 1, 1999 and December 13, 2000, the Department licensed **seven** aggregators and **nine** suppliers. As of December 13, 2000, one application for an aggregator and three applications for a supplier license are pending approval.

The time period taken to process a license application commences from the date the application is complete to the regular meeting date at which time the final decision is made to grant the applicant its license. It has taken an average of 69 days to process each of these applications.

In sum, since the Department began receiving license applications on June 14, 1999, a total of ten aggregators and nine suppliers have been licensed by the Department.
