ORDER APPROVING EXPERIMENTAL LOW INCOME TARIFF

On October 1, 2001, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a division of Southern Union Company, submitted tariff sheets that create an experimental low-income program. MGE was directed to establish such a program in an Order Approving Second Revised Stipulation and Agreement issued by the Commission on July 5, 2001. MGE's tariff carries an effective date of November 1, 2001.

On October 25, 2001, the Staff of the Commission filed a recommendation and memorandum indicating that it has reviewed the tariff sheets and finds that they comply with the Commission's order. Staff indicates that the provisions in the tariff are the result of extensive discussions and consensus among MGE, Staff, and the Office of the Public Counsel. Staff recommends that the tariffs be approved to be effective November 1, 2001.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing and the Staff memorandum, and has determined that the filing complies with the Commission's order and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheets (Tariff File No. 200200242) filed October 1, 2001, are hereby approved to become effective on November 1, 2001.
